1943

Nov 20th The Rector (Rev Harold Smith) urged the necessity of a Church/Parish Hall for the Village and it was decided an account should be opened and an appeal made for a Parish Hall Fund

1944

Feb 19th Parish Hall had made a good start and that the balance in hand so far was £102.4.8

1946

July 31st Some discussion whether it should be Church Hall or Parish Hall. The Church Hall appeal was recognized by Diocese as a commendable Scheme and meeting the requirements of "Post War Effort" expected by all Parishes.

1946 July 31st cont. Talk of possible purchase of Glebe land.

1949 license to build but quotes of £3400 and £4000 too high.

July Garden Party and Flower Show by Church raised £272 to go into account.

1949 August Price of land for hall suggested as £5 plus legal expenses

1950

A.G.M. Church Hall account

1946 - 49

May 1950 After lengthy discussion it was decided that the Church could not take on any further financial responsibilities. In addition to cost of erection (£1526) there would be the cost of lighting, heating and furnishing.

1958 £600 in account.
