property in trust for the Duke of Bedford for 500 years.

Copy Conveyance
4th February 1843 Appointment of "5 acre field/ Dell Field": 5 acres 2 rods 27
perches arable "8 acres" (9 acres arable) "Further Field"
(8 acres 27 perches) meadow - Chenies to the use of the Duke
of Bedford. Thomas Wing to hold land in trust for the Duke.
Consideration £740 paid to Earl Fitzwilliam and the Earl of
Yarborough.

Agreement
15th February 1856 To lease Old House Farm on a yearly term. Rent £192 p.a.
Francis, Duke of Bedford (signed by his steward Thomas Bennet)
From Charles Compton Cavendish of Latimer.
