

APPORTIONMENT OF THE RENT-CHARGE IN LIEU OF TITHES IN THE PARISH OF CHENIES IN
THE COUNTY OF BUCKINGHAMSHIRE

Whereas an Agreement and Supplemental Article thereunto annexed for the Commutation of Tithes in the Parish of Chenies in the County of Buckingham were, on the sixteenth day of January in the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty Eight, confirmed by the Tithe Commissioners for England and Wales, of which Agreement and Supplemental Article, with the Schedule annexed to the Agreement, the following are Copies-

Articles of Agreement for the Commutation of the Tithes of the Parish of Chenies in the County of Buckingham in pursuance of the Act for the Commutation of Tithes in England and Wales made and executed at a Meeting duly called and holden at the Beford Arms Inn in the said Parish on the twenty ninth day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty seven according to the provisions of the said Act By and Between the several owners of land within the said Parish by whom or by whose Agents duly authorised in that behalf these Presents are executed and the Interest of which Landowners in the Lands of the said Parish is not less than two thirds of the Lands therein subject to Tithes of one part and the Reverend and Right Honourable Lord Wriothlesley Russell Clerk Rector of the said Parish and Owner of all the Tithes as well Great as Small thereof of the other part. It is by these Present Witnessed that at the said Meeting it hath been and is mutually agreed upon by and between all the said Parties Presents in manner following that is to say - That the annual Sum of Four Hundred and twenty one Pounds six shillings and eight pence by way of Rent charge subject to variation as in the said Act provided and subject to the other provisions therein contained, shall be payable and paid to the said Wriothlesley Russell as Rector of the said Parish and Owner of the Tithes thereof and to his Successors instead of all the Tithes as well Great as Small of the Lands of the said Parish subject to Tithes including an ancient due of One pound six shillings and eight pence heretofore payable out of the Estate of His Grace The Duke of Bedford and including Tithe of Glebe the Rent charge in lieu of which it is hereby agreed shall be fixed at the Sum of Ten pounds in respect of all the Tithes Great as well as Small of the Glebe Lands of the said Parish and which Sum it is hereby agreed Shall be apportioned exclusively upon the said Glebe Lands and instead of all Moduses and Compositions real and prescriptive and customary payments payable in respect of all the Lands of the said Parish or the produce thereof a summary description of which Lands is contained in the Schedule herewith annexed.

In testimony whereof the said Parties to these Presents or their respective Agents thereunto duly authorized in their names and on their behalf have to these Presents subscribed and set their respective hands and seals.

SCHEDULE

to the above articles of Agreement containing a statement of all the particulars required by the said Act to be set forth or otherwise requisite for the purposes of this Agreement.

The whole Parish of Chenies aforesaid contains Sixtenn Hundred and ninety acres of Land estimated measure.

The whole quantity of the lands of the said Parish which are subject to the payment of any kind of Tithes is Fourteen Hundred and twenty one Acres two roods and thirty four perches estimated measure.

The whole quantity of land subject to Tithes within the said Parish which is cultivated as Arable land is Twelve Hunded acres one rood and nineteen perches estimated measure.

The whole quantity of land subject to Tithes within the said Parish cultivated as Meadow or Pasture land is Two Hundred and six acres one rood and thirty five perches estimated measure.

The whole quantity of the Glebe Land of the said Parish which if not in the hands of the Owner would be subject to Tithes amounts to twenty eight acres one rood and ten perches estimated measure.

The whole quantity of Common land subject to Tithes within the said Parish is Fourteen Acres three roods and twenty perches estimated measure.

The undermentioned lands within the said Parish are and have been exempt from the payment of Tithes (that is to say):-

The Woodlands by custom of the Country Two Hundred and sixty two Acres and twelve perches and the River Six Acres and thirty four perches.

Supplemental Article to the within Agreement

It is hereby witnessed and the Parties to the within Agreement Do hereby declare it to be their Will and intention that the lands included in the said Agreement shall be discharged from the payment of Tithes and that the said Rent charge shall commence from the first day of October next preceding the Confirmation of the said apportionment.

In witness whereof the said Parties have hereunto set their hands the day and year hereinbefore written.

Now I, Thomas Bennett of Woburn in the County of Bedford having been duly appointed Valuer to apportion the Total Sum agreed to be by way of Rent charge in lieu of Tithes amongst the several Lands of the said Parish of Chenies Do hereby apportion the Rent charges as follows:-

Gross Rent Charge payable to the Titheowner in Lieu of Tithes for the Parish of Chenies in the County of Buckingham Four Hundred and twenty one Pounds six shillings and eight pence.

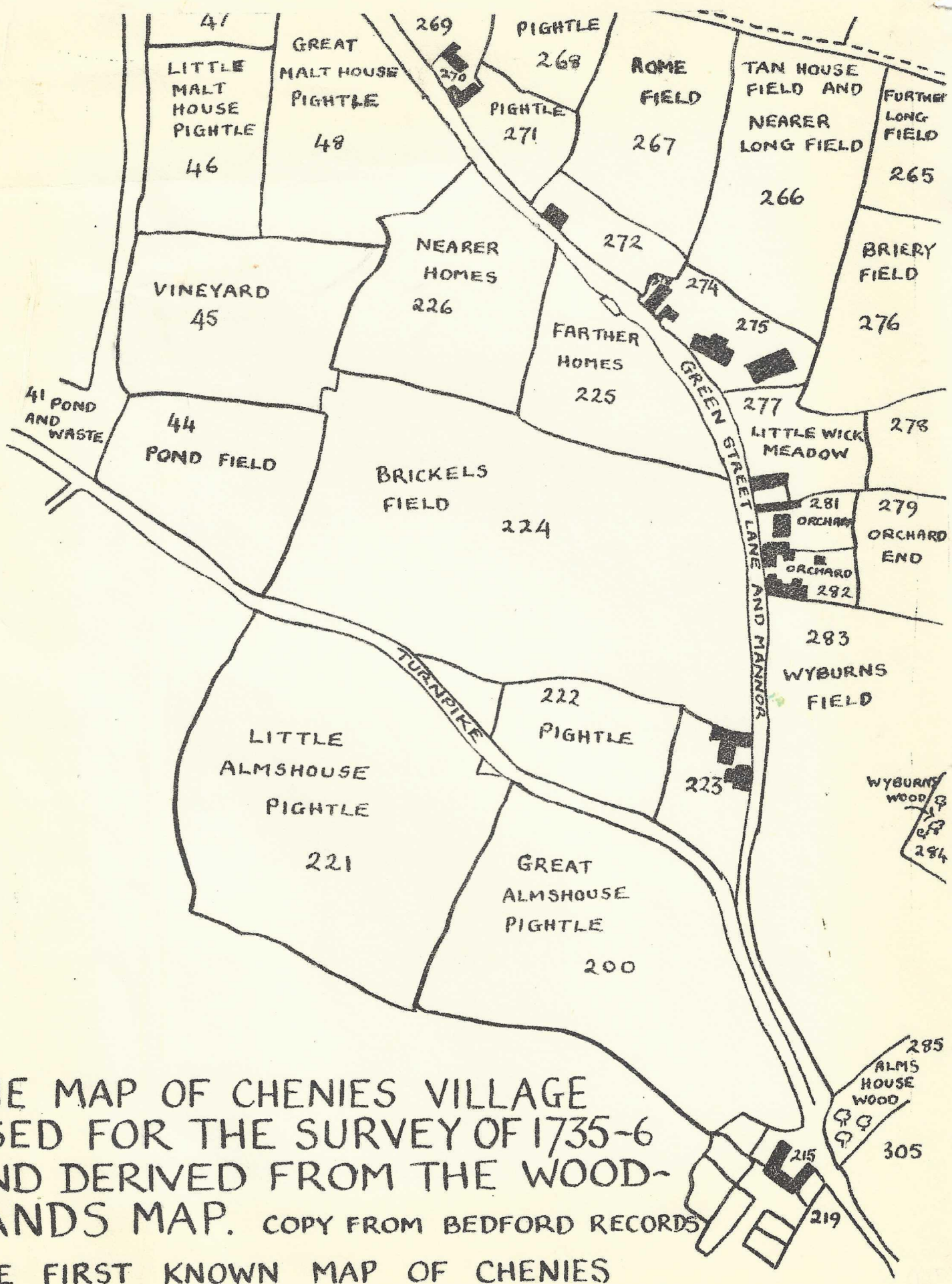
